100 seniors in the United States and Israel participated in an exciting transatlantic event, at the Hod Center operated by CLICK. The evening was accompanied by music and singing organized by Ortal Harpaz and Yael Shiron, two social workers at CLICK. This groundbreaking initiative involved seniors interacting online in their homes, through a video conferencing program connected to their television sets. On a daily basis they participate in virtual activities such as exercise classes, interest groups, singing, lectures, chikong, mediation, cognitive development and more. The Virtual Center for Senior's was founded in 2015 by CLICK and is supported by Eshel-Joint, the Special Projects Fund in the National Insurance Institute, the Ministry of Social Affairs, Myisrael and the HOT fund.
